Students have the amazing opportunity to visit some of the most fascinating places from Ancient Rome, where are led by our professors to read the original texts from classical literature narrating the extraordinary events that took place exactly where they are right know! Moreover, students are welcomed to attend lessons for our students in our school. Please note that each and every lesson is held in Latin or Ancient Greek!

The IISC offers several options among which you can choose the one that better suits you, depending on how much time you intend to spend. Once all the needs and requirements are discussed, the IISC and the High School's teachers settle the calendar, the hours and all the relevant details.

Classrooms

Because lessons are held entirely in the target language through the direct and active use of Latin and Ancient Greek, they are particularly engaging. Indeed, the IISC has developed a new methodology which, through the direct use of the language, allows students to acquire not only the ability to read and completely understand a text in Latin or Ancient Greek in the original language in a quick and steady way, but also the fundamentals of *ars scribendi*. Indeed, students are encouraged to make a direct and active use of language since the very beginning: professors only speak Latin or Ancient Greek, according to IISC methodology, consisting in a combination of tradition and innovation: it includes the most recent principles of contemporary language teaching methodology and it is mainly based on the tenets of the so-called inductive-contextual method, founded on the tradition of ancient humanistic schools. Indeed, the active and direct use of Latin and Ancient Greek as an instrument for language acquisition is not, as many could think, a modern invention. The direct methods have been indeed used for teaching Latin and Ancient Greek almost continually from Roman to Modern Ages. Usually, the details of the lessons are agreed upon well in advance and professors at IISC are appropriately informed about the didactic level of the classes, so that lessons take into the appropriate consideration the students' previous knowledge.

Lessons are held in wide classrooms, equipped with all the most innovative didactic and digital materials, where more than one class can be easily welcomed.



Guided Tours¹

Because languages are actively employed, Highschoolers can appreciate their never-ending impact in those very places where they are born. Walking around the Roman Forum and the Colosseum, students are led to *experience* them thanks to the direct voices of poets, authors and philosopher from ancient Rome whose words are commented and explained by the IISC professors in Latin or ancient Greek. The beauty of Rome and the words of great poets and authors who modelled our culture create an all-comprehensive cultural experience that strongly impacts young students.
